Anyone interested in creative woodturning is invited to join nationally acclaimed woodturner, artist and teacher Beth Ireland for a one day presentation as she demonstrates using the bandsaw as a complimentary tool to a lathe to create dramatic and original pieces. She will finish the day sharing tricks and gadgets she has developed from her 28 years as a production woodturner and furniture maker. This will include some tool making and sharpening.

Beth holds a Bachelor's degree in Art Education from State University College in Buffalo, NY, and a Masters degree in Sculpture from the Massachusetts College of Art.



She has run Beth Ireland Woodworking since 1982. The company specializes in architectural woodturning, furniture and cabinetry. Beth has lectured, taught and demonstrated throughout New England, including a stint as Director of the Wood Program at Worcester Center for Crafts. Her artistic woodturnings have been seen in galleries throughout the United States and in publications such as Bead and Button, and Design Book 7 by Taunton Press. She currently resides and works in Roslindale, MA.
